The North Norfolk District Council (Off-Street Parking Places) Order, 1982

Notice is hereby given that the North Norfolk District Council propose to make an Order under sections 31 (1), (2), (4) and 84 (d) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967 as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968 Schedule 19 to the Local Government Act 1972 and Schedule 6 to the Local Government Act 1974 to control the use of the parking places named in the Schedule to this notice, which shows the class of vehicles, the days and times of operation, the maximum period for waiting and the scale of charges proposed for each parking place.
