(a) a pedestrian controlled vehicle being used by the Post Office for collecting or delivering postal packets;
(b) a vehicle being used for the conveyance of a disabled person who at the time has a current permission to enter the Lowestoft Pedestrian Zone in a vehicle (whether as a driver or passenger) granted by the Waveney District Council and clearly displaying a permit issued by the said Council denoting such permission: permission ;

(c) an unridden bicycle.

# ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1967 SECTION 1

The Manchester-Hyde-Mottram Trunk Road (A57) (One-Way Traffic) Order 1982
