(2) To prohibit the waiting of vehicles on the length of road specified in Schedule 2 to this notice:

(a) for a longer period than 12 hours; or

(b) if a period of less than 12 hours has elapsed since the termination of the last period of waiting (if any) of a vehicle on that length of road.
