*The London Borough of Sutton (Off-Street Parking Places, Pay and Display) (Amendment) Order 1982*

Notice is hereby given that the Council of the London Borough of Sutton proposes to make an Order under sections 28 (1) and 31 (1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967 (as amended). The Order will be called "The London Borough of Sutton (Off-Street Parking Places, Pay and Display) (Amendment) Order 1982". The effect of the Order is to consolidate existing amendments to the Schedule to The London Borough of Sutton (Off-Street Parking Places—Pay and Display) Order 1978 (as amended) (hereinafter referred to as the "1978 Order") and to introduce further amendments to the Schedule to the 1978 Order as follows:

(1) It will delete the parking places at Forsdick Yard, Grosvenor Road, Wallington and Brighton Road, Sutton from the Schedule.

(2) It will introduce a revised scale of charges incorporating certain increases for motor cars and commercial vehicles not exceeding 2½ tons as follows:

No charge for cars of disabled drivers and motorcycles parked in designated parking bays.

(b) *At West Street Parking Place, Sutton*

25p up to 1 hour

40p for 1 to 2 hours

50p for 2 to 3 hours

(maximum stay, 3 hours)
