NEW TOWNS ACT 1981

The New Town of Redditch, Extinguishment of Public Rights of Way, Part of Footpath No 73, Redditch

Notice is hereby given that the Secretary of State for the Environment in exercise of his powers under section 23 of the New Towns Act 1981, proposes to make an Order extinguishing the public rights of way over the following highway shown coloured red on the map hereinafter referred to:

That part of footpath No. 73 from its junction with Callow Hill at a point marked A on the map and running in a north-westerly direction for a distance of approximately 380 metres to a point marked D on the map.

A map showing the rights of way proposed to be extinguished and the alternative route to be provided may be inspected at the offices of the Redditch Development Corporation, Holmwood, Plymouth Road, Redditch during normal office hours. Any objection to this proposal must be made in writing clearly stating all the grounds of objection and addressed to the Secretary of State for the Environment (Ref.
