THE HIGHWAYS ACT 1980

The London-Fishguard Trunk Road (Improvement at Travellers Rest Junction Side Roads) Order 1982

The Secretary of State for Wales hereby gives notice that, in relation to the above-mentioned Trunk Road at Travellers Rest, Carmarthen, in the County of Dyfed, he has made under section 14 of the Highways Act 1980 an Order, the effect of which is:

- (a) to authorise him:
 - (i) to improve, raise, lower or otherwise alter Kennel Road;
 - (ii) to stop up Kennel Road;
 - (iii) to construct a new highway to connect Kennel Road (as improved) with the Trunk Road

all at Travellers Rest, Carmarthen aforesaid, and

(b) to provide for the transfer of the said new highway to the County Council of Dyfed as from the date on which he notifies the Council that the new highway has been completed and is open for through traffic.

Copies of the Order and of the relevant plan have been deposited at the Welsh Office, Transport and Highways Group, Government Buildings, Ty Glas Road, Llanishen, Cardiff CF4 5PL, and at the offices of Dyfed County Council, County Hall, Carmarthen, and the Dyfed County Council, Highways and Transportation Department, Llanstephan Road, Carmarthen, where they are open to inspection free of charge at all reasonable hours.

Copies of the Order, the title of which is "The London-Fishguard Trunk Road (Improvement at Travellers Rest Junction Side Roads) Order 1982" can be obtained from the Welsh Office, Transport and Highways Group, Government Buildings, Ty Glas Road, Llanishen, Cardiff CP4-5PI.

Any person aggrieved by the Order and desiring to question the validity thereof, or of any provision contained therein, on the ground that it is not within the powers of the Highways Act 1980, or on the ground that any requirement of that Act, or of regulations made

thereunder, has not been complied with in relation to the Order, may, within 6 weeks from 19th March 1982, or within 6 weeks from the date of publication of this notice, if such period shall expire later, apply to the High Court for the suspension or quashing of the Order or of any provision contained therein.

HIGHWAYS ACT 1980

The Fishguard—Bangor (Menai Suspension Bridge) Trunk Road (Closure of Access to Premises at Pen Parc Village) Order 1982.

The Secretary of State for Wales hereby gives notice that he has made, under section 12 of the Highways Act 1980, an Order (entitled as above), the effect of which is to authorise him to stop up private means of access to premises from the Fishguard—Bangor (Menai Suspension Bridge) Trunk Road at Pen Parc, Cardigan, Dyfed.

Copies of the Order, as made, and of the relevant plan may be inspected free of charge at all reasonable hours at the Welsh Office, Transport and Highways Group, Government Buildings, Ty. Glas Road, Llanishen, Cardiff CF4 5PL, and at the Post Office, Pen Parc, Cardigan, Dyfed.

Any person aggrieved by the Order and desiring to question the validity thereof, or of any provision contained therein, on the ground that it is not within the powers of the Highways Act 1980 or on the grounds that any requirement of that Act or of any regulations made thereunder has not been complied with in relation to the Order, may, within 6 weeks of 19th March 1982, apply to the High Court for the suspension or quashing of the Order or of any provision contained therein.
