Any person who desires to question the validity of, or of any provision contained, in, the Order, on the ground that it is not within the powers with respect to the Order conferred by the above Act, or on the ground that any requirement of, or of any instrument made under, any provision of that Act has not been complied with in relation to the Order, may within 6 weeks of the 6th April 1982 apply to the High Court for the suspension or quashing of the Order or of any provision contained therein.
