NOTICE OF APPLICATION TO VARY A LICENCE TO ABSTRACT WATER

Notice is hereby given that an application is being made to the Severn-Trent Water Authority by H.S.S. (Precision Moulds) Ltd., of Aston Fields Industrial Estate, 34 Sherwood Road, Bromsgrove, Worcs., to vary licence serial number I8/54/7/200/S to abstract water from The Sugar Brook at NGR S.O. 960 690.

CLEAN AIR ACT 1956

Suspension of the North Tyneside Smoke Control Order No. 30, 1981

Notice is hereby given that on 2nd June 1981 the North Tyneside Metropolitan Borough Council in exercise of their powers conferred on them by section 11 of the Clean Air Act 1956, as amended by the Local Government, Planning and Land Act 1980 made an Order entitled "The North Tyneside Smoke Control Order No. 30, 1981" declaring the area mentioned therein to be a Smoke Control Area.

Notice is hereby given that the Council of the Borough of North Tyneside in exercise of their powers conferred on them by section 11 (5) of the Clean Air Act 1956, as amended by the Local Government, Planning and Land Act 1980 have resolved to suspend the North Tyneside Smoke Control Order No. 30,

1981, which was to have come into operation on 1st July 1982.
This means that the operation of section 11 of the Clean Air
Act 1956, as amended by the Local Government, Planning
and Land Act 1980 shall be suspended until 1st April 1983.

The North Tyneside Smoke Control Area No. 30, 1981

An area bounded by a line commencing in the centre of the roundabout at the junction of Benton Road and the Cramlington to Tyne Tunnel Spine Road (A1) at Holystone and proceeding north westwards via the centre of the road, thence north-eastwards via the Northern Borough Boundary, thence south-eastwards via the footpath adjacent to the Backworth/ Seghill mineral railway line, thence westwards and southwards via the old Tynemouth-Seaton Valley Borough Boundary, thence westwards via the centre of Benton Road to the point of commencement.
