##### NOTICE OF PROPOSAL TO MODIFY PUBLIC PATH ORDER

*The County of Devon (South Devon Coast Path) (Man Sands to Kelly's Cove) Public Path Creation Order 1975.*

Notice is hereby given pursuant to paragraph 2 (3) of the Sixth Schedule to the Highways Act 1980 and the Secretary of State for the Environment proposes to modify The County of Devon (South Devon Coast Path) (Man Sands to Kelly's Cove) Public Path Creation Order 1975 by altering the proposed route of the path shown on the map attached to the Order and previously proposed to be modified by the Secretary of State, as follows:

from point A the path to follow the cliff top along the eastern boundary of Field OS 2531 instead of running immediately in front of the former coastguards cottages as proposed in the Order, or behind them as previously proposed as a modification following a local inquiry in 1976, to a point marked C on a section of path running along the eastern boundary of Field OS 1818 forming the cliff edge, which section is itself a modification of the Order route.

A copy of the Order as submitted, a map showing the modifications previously proposed, and a map showing the modification now proposed, have been deposited at the offices of the County Secretary, County Hall, Exeter, and at the offices of the Area Secretary (South) 75 Abbey Road, Torquay, and may be inspected free of charge during normal office hours.
