CLEAN AIR ACTS 1956 AND 1968

(As Amended by the Local Government, Planning AND LAND ACT 1980)

The Proposed South Tyneside No. 12 Smoke Control Örder 1982

Notice is hereby given that the Council of the Borough of South Tyneside in exercise of the powers conferred on them by section 11 of the Clean Air Act 1956, as amended by Schedule 2 to the Local Government Planning and Land Act 1980, propose to make an Order which, if made, would be entitled The South Tyneside No. 12 Smoke Control Order 1982. This would declare the area described in the Schedule happing to be a Smoke Control Area. in the Schedule hereto to be a Smoke Control Area,

Subject to the exemptions effected by the proposed Order, if on any day after the proposed Order has come into operation, smoke is emitted from a chimney of any buildoperation, smoke is emitted from a chimney of any building within the Smoke Control Area, the occupier of that building shall be guilty of an offence and liable to a fine not exceeding £100 unless he proves that the smoke was not caused by the use of any fuel other than an authorised fuel. The authorised fuels include anthracite, coke and other solid smokeless fuels (such as "Homefire', "Coalite", "Sunbrite", "Rexco", "Taybrite" and "Phurnacite") and gas and electricity. Oil is not an authorised fuel but appliances designed to burn oil are exempt and may be used.

Subject to the provisions of section 9 of the Clean-Air Act 1968, any person who acquires for use in a Smoke Control Area or who sells by retail for delivery in a Smoke Control Area any solid fuel other than an authorised fuel shall be guilty of an offence and liable to a fine not exceeding £100.

If made, the Order will not come into operation before

1st November 1983.

July 1982.
