KINGSWOOD DISTRICT COUNCIL CONTROL OF POLLUTION ACT 1974

Kingswood (No. 2) Noise Abatement Zone. Central Kingswood

Notice is hereby given that the Kingswood District Council in exercise of the powers conferred on them by part 5 of schedule 1 of the Control of Pollution Act 1974 have passed a resolution postponing the coming into operation of the Kingswood (No. 2) Noise Abatement Order 1980 until 30th April 1983.

Borough of Fareham (Longfield Avenue, Fareham) (Prohibition of Waiting) Order 1982

The Hampshire (Various Roads, Ringwood) (30-40 miles per hour speed limit) Order 1982
