

## SOUTH YORKSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL

*(Parking Places and Controlled Parking Zone) (Barnsley) Order 1978 (Amendment No. ) Order 1982*

Notice is hereby given that the South Yorkshire County Council proposes to make an Order under sections 1(1), (2) (3) and 84D(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968, Schedule 19 to the Local Government Act 1972 and Schedule 6 to the Road Traffic Act 1974.

The effect of the proposed Order will be to amend the South Yorkshire County Council (Parking Places and Controlled Parking Zone) (Barnsley) Order 1978 in so far as it relates to restrictions on waiting by vehicles in parts of Shambles Street, Barnsley in the Barnsley Metropolitan District.

The existing limited waiting restrictions as described in Part I of the Schedule to this notice are to be revoked and substituted with those described in Part II of this Schedule.

The Order contains the usual waiting exceptions and the usual exceptions for disabled persons' vehicles.

A copy of the proposed Order together with a map showing the restricted road and a statement of the County Council's reasons for proposing to make the Order may be examined during normal office hours at the offices of (i) the County Council, County Hall, Barnsley and (ii) Central Library, Shambles Street, Barnsley.

If you wish to object to the proposed Order you should send the grounds for your objection in writing to the undersigned by 9th August 1982.

<i>Shambles Street</i>	North-east side—from the north-eastern kerb-line of Summer Lane to the junction with Fenton Street and from a point 15 metres west of the western kerb-line of St. Mary's Place to a point 15 metres east of the eastern kerb-line of St. Mary's Place.

## PART II

The following items to be substituted for the item to be deleted in Part I of this Schedule:

(a) <i>Parking Place</i>	
14. Shambles Street	North side—from a point 78 metres west of the junction with St. Mary's Place for a distance of 91 metres in a westerly direction; and
(b) <i>Roads and Parts of roads in which waiting is restricted 24 hours a day all days of the week:</i>	
Shambles Street	North-east side—from the north-eastern kerb-line of Summer Lane to a point 169 metres west of its junction with St. Mary's Place. North side—from a point 16 metres west of the western kerb-line of St. Mary's Place to a point 15 metres east of the eastern kerb-line of St. Mary's Place and from its junction with the eastern kerb-line of Church Street for a distance of 15 metres westerly. ## WEST YORKSHIRE METROPOLITAN COUNTY COUNCIL

*(Kirklees) (Traffic Regulation) (No. 5) Order 1982*

Notice is hereby given that the West Yorkshire Metropolitan County Council made the above-named Order on 19th July 1982 under their powers in the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended, the effect of which, in so far as it relates to roads at Huddersfield, is:

- (a) to prohibit waiting by vehicles at all times in lengths of Beck Road, Bradford Road/Northgate, lay-by on the east side of Bradford Road (at its junction with Alder Street), Bradford Road link, Connecting Road between Oxford Street and Northgate (opposite Green Street), Green Street, Lower Viaduct Street and Oxford Street.
- (b) to prohibit waiting by vehicles from 8 a.m. to 6 p.m. on Mondays to Saturdays in a length of St. John's Road and further lengths of Beck Road.

The Order comes into operation on Monday, 26th July 1982. A copy of the Order (which contains the usual exemptions) together with a map showing the restricted roads may be examined during normal office hours at the Reception desk at the main entrance to County Hall, Wakefield, at the County Council's office, Albion Street, Huddersfield and at Room 401, Administration Department, Kirklees House, Huddersfield.

If you wish to question the validity of the Order or of any provision contained therein on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended, or on the grounds that any requirement of that Act, or of any instrument made under it, has not been complied with in relation to the Order you may, within 6 weeks from the date upon which the Order was made (i.e. 19th July 1982), apply to the High Court for this purpose.
