THE WELSH WATER AUTHORITY

(Llyn-Craig-y-Pistyll) (Drought) Order 1982

Notice is hereby given that in exercise of the powers conferred upon him by section 1 of the Drought Act 1976, the Secretary of State for Wales on 15th July 1982 made the above-mentioned Order.

The effect of the Order is to permit the Authority to suspend the provisions of section 23 of the Aberystwyth Rural District Council Act 1937 and of Licence Serial Number 23/64/12/1 of 25th October 1965 issued by the Gwynedd River Authority (as varied by an endorsement made thereon having effect as from 25th January 1971) thereby enabling the Authority to discharge a minimum quantity of 50,000 gallons of water per day from Llyn-Craig-y-Pistyll Reservoir into the Afon Leri.

The Order came into effect on 16th July 1982 and shall remain in force until and including 15th January 1983.
