(7) To prohibit waiting at any time on the east and west sides of the eastern access to Back Dalton Street South from its junction with Dalton Street for a distance of 14 metres in a southerly direction.

Exemptions will permit waiting for the purpose of picking up and setting down passengers, loading and unloading goods, the maintenance of roads, the supply of gas, electricity and water and for disabled persons.
