The Hartlepool Borough Council (John Street) (Prohibition of Waiting) Order 1982

Notice is hereby given that Hartlepool Borough Council, pursuant to arrangements made under section 101 of the Local Government Act 1972 with the County Council of Cleveland in exercise of the powers of the said County Council under sections 1 (1), (2) and (3) and 84D of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968, Schedule 19 of the Local Government Act 1972 and Schedule 6 of the Road Traffic Act 1974, propose to make an Order the effect of which will be to prohibit waiting at any time in that length of John Street from its junction with Lynn Street in an easterly direction for a distance of 20 metres.

Exemptions will permit waiting for the purpose of picking up and setting down passengers, loading and unloading goods, the maintenance of roads, the supply of gas, electricity and water and for disabled persons.

A copy of the proposed Order together with a statement of the Council's reasons for the proposal and a plan showing the roads concerned may be inspected between 9 a.m. and 4.30 p.m. Monday to Friday at the Civic Centre, Victoria Road, Hartlepool. HARTLEPOOL BOROUGH COUNCIL

The Hartlepool Borough Council (Lauder Street and Avenue Road) (Prohibition of Waiting) Order 1982

Notice is hereby given that Hartlepool Borough Council, pursuant to arrangements made under section 101 of the Local Government Act 1972 with the County Council of Cleveland in exercise of the powers of the said County Council under sections 1 (1), (2) and (3) and 84D of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968, Schedule 19 of the Local Government Act 1972 and Schedule 6 of the Road Traffic Act 1974, propose to make an Order the effect of which will be to prohibit waiting at any time:

(1) On both sides of Lauder Street from a point 7 metres east of its junction with Avenue Road for a distance of 70 metres in an easterly direction.

(2) On the west side of Avenue Road from a point 14 metres north of its junction with Middleton Grange Lane for a distance of 20 metres in a northerly direction.

Exemptions will permit waiting for the purpose of picking up and setting down passengers, loading and unloading goods, the maintenance of roads, the supply of gas, electricity and water and for disabled persons.

A copy of the proposed Order together with a statement of the Council's reasons for the proposal and a plan showing the roads concerned may be inspected between 9 a.m. and 4.30 p.m. Monday to Friday at the Civic Centre, Victoria Road, Hartlepool.

ISLE OF WIGHT COUNTY COUNCIL

The County Council of Isle of Wight (The Esplanade, Ryde, Isle of Wight) (Coach Parking Places and Restriction of Waiting) Order No. 1, 1982.

Notice is hereby given that the County Council of Isle of Wight in exercise of their powers under sections 1 (1), (2), (3), 28 (1) and 31 (1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police have made an Order the effect of which will be:

(1) To reserve, for the exclusive use for parking of motor coaches the northern side of The Esplanade, Ryde, from 45 feet west to 355 feet west of Quay Road between the hours of 8 a.m. and 6 p.m. (maximum of 2 hours in any 4) on every day of the week between 1st April and 31st October.

(2) To provide limited waiting in the stated length between 1st November and 31st March (30 minutes in any hour).

The Order came into operation on Wednesday, 28th July 1982.

Any person who desires to question the validity of the said Order on the grounds that it is not within the powers of section 1 of the said Act as amended or on the grounds that any requirement of the Act or any instrument made under it has not been complied with in relation to this Order may, within 6 weeks of the date hereof, apply to the High Court for the purpose.
