

## NEWCASTLE-UPON-TYNE CITY COUNCIL

*The City of Newcastle-upon-Tyne (Halewood Avenue/ Kirkwood Drive) (Prohibition of Waiting) Order 1982*

Notice is hereby given that the City of Newcastle-upon-Tyne, as agents for the Tyne and Wear County Council, propose to make an Order under sections 1 (1), (2) and (3) and 84D (1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968, Schedule 19 to the Local Government Act 1972 and Schedule 6 to the Road Traffic Act 1974.

The proposed Order will revoke the existing 8 a.m. to 6.30 p.m. (Monday to Saturday) waiting restriction on the west side of Halewood Avenue from its junction with Hillview Avenue in a northerly direction to its junction with Kirkwood Drive and will replace it with prohibition of waiting at any time. Waiting at any time will also be prohibited on the south side of Kirkwood Drive from its junction with Halewood Avenue in a westerly direction for a distance of 90 metres.

Exemptions in the Order would permit waiting for certain purposes, including:

- (a) picking up and setting down passengers;
- (b) loading and unloading goods; and
- (c) for disabled persons.
