**BRITISH TELECOMMUNICATIONS**

NOTE: The Scheme which follows this Note has been made under section 21 of the British Telecommunications Act 1981 and will come into operation on 1st October 1982. The new Scheme consolidates with amendments and omissions the provisions of the previous Telegram Scheme. The principal changes made by the Scheme are: (i) the withdrawal of Telegrams to places within the United Kingdom and the Isle of Man except Telemesssage telegrams; (ii) the introduction of multi-address Telemesssage telegrams; (iii) the changes of rates for Telegrams to the Republic of Ireland; (iv) the withdrawal of certain international telegram services including the Urgent and Letter Telegrams and (v) the withdrawal of certain services and facilities provided in respect of Telegrams.
