Notice is hereby given that the Council of the County of North Yorkshire propose to make an Order under section 1 (1), (2) and (3) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967 as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968, Schedule 19 to the Local Government Act 1972 and Schedule 6 to the Road Traffic Act 1974, the effect of which will be to prohibit vehicles from waiting (except for certain exempted purposes including the loading and unloading of goods) at any time in any length of road specified in the following table:

WEST MIDLANDS COUNTY COUNCIL

The West Midlands County Council (Station Road/Flaxley Road, Stechford) (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting) (Amendment) Order 1982

Notice is hereby given that the County Council of West Midlands propose to make an Order under sections 1 (1), (2), (3) and 84 D (1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967 as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968 section 186 and Schedule 19 to the Local Government Act 1972 section 24 and Schedule 6 to the Road Traffic Act 1974 the effect of which will be as follows:

- To prohibit waiting at any time in Station Road: North east side, from a point 7 yards south-east of the line of the kerb on the south-east side of Iron Lane to a point 32 yards north-west of the line of the kerb on the north-west side of Iron Lane;
North-east side, from a point 20 yards south-east of the line of the kerb on the south side of Flaxley Road to a point 84 yards north-west of the line of the kerb on the north side of Flaxley Road.
- To prohibit waiting between 7.30 a.m. to 9.30 a.m. and 4.30 p.m. to 6.30 p.m. Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday and Friday in the lengths of road listed in the Schedule hereto.
- To limit waiting to 1 hour return prohibited within 1 hour between the hours of 9.30 a.m. to 4.30 p.m. on Monday,

Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday, Friday and Saturday in the lengths of road listed in the schedule hereto.

Full details of the proposals are in the draft Order which together with a map and a statement of the Council's reasons for the proposals may be examined at the offices of the County Secretary, West Midlands County Council, County Hall, 1 Lancaster Circus, Queensway, Birmingham B4 7DJ, during normal working hours.
