The Order has the following effect:

New charges from 2nd October 1982 at the multi-storey car parks at Springbridge Road\*, London W.5, and Singapore Road, London W.13:

*Springbridge Road\**, Monday to Saturday 0800 to 1800 any period not exceeding 2 hours, 25p; each additional hour or part, 10p; season tickets, £135 plus V.A.T. p.a.

*Singapore Road*, Monday to Saturday 0800 to 1800, 25p per visit; season tickets, £75 plus V.A.T. p.a.

New charges from 2nd October 1982 at these surface car parks:

New charges from 2nd October 1982 at these surface car parks:

*Steyne Road*, London W.3 (opposite Nelson Place), *Steyne Road*, London W.3 (opposite P.H.), £7 plus V.A.T. per month.

*Roslin Road*, London W.3; *Bollo Lane*, London W.3, £1.10 plus V.A.T. per week.

Car parks marked with an asterisk are pay and display and standard charge payable if ticket not bought in advance has been increased to £10 (£5 if paid within 14 days).

Surface car park at Uxbridge Road, London W.5 (rear of Town Hall), open 0700 to 2400 Saturday only. All others mentioned open all hours all week. Sunday and Bank Holidays are free. Vehicles not exceeding 2½ tons or 6½ feet only.

The car park at the former "Skid Pan" site Kensington Road Northholt will now be open to heavy goods vehicles for day time parking.

#### GATESHEAD METROPOLITAN BOROUGH COUNCIL

*The Borough Council of Gateshead (Poplar Crescent and Claremont South Avenue) (Prohibition of Driving) Order 1982.*

#### MID GLAMORGAN COUNTY COUNCIL

*Mid Glamorgan County Council (Llantrisant Road, Pen-y-coedcae Road and Associated Unclassified Roads, Pen-y-coedcae; Various Streets, Graig, Pontypridd) (Prohibition of Heavy Commercial Vehicles of over 7.5 Tonnes Maximum Gross Weight) Order 1982.*

Notice is hereby given that on 23rd September 1982 the Mid Glamorgan County Council made an Order under section 1 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968, Schedule 19 to the Local Government Act 1972, section 1 of the Heavy Commercial Vehicles (Controls and Regulations) Act 1973, Schedule 6 to the Road Traffic Act 1974 and Schedule 7 to the Local Government Planning and Land Act 1980, the effect of which is that no heavy commercial vehicle shall proceed in any of the roads or lengths of roads specified in the Schedule to this notice. A "Heavy Commercial Vehicle" has a maximum gross weight of 7.5 tonnes and an unladen weight exceeding 3.05 tonnes.

Exemptions will be provided in the Order to enable heavy commercial vehicles to use the specified roads for the conveyance of goods to or from any premises situated on or adjacent to the roads or lengths of roads concerned; for any agricultural or tree felling purposes on adjacent land; building, industrial or demolition operations; the removal of obstructions to traffic; roadworks; the maintenance of essential services; fire brigade, police or ambulance purposes; to enable vehicles to be garaged, serviced or repaired; in performance of statutory powers or duties; in connection with any circus, fair or other event held in the roads or lengths of roads or in the vicinity or for the sale of goods from the vehicle.

The Order came into operation on 1st October 1982 and a copy thereof and a map showing the roads and lengths of roads to which the Order relates may be inspected at the offices of the Mid Glamorgan County Council, Cathays Park, Cardiff, during normal office hours until the end of 6 weeks from 1st October 1982.

Any person wishing to question the validity of the Order or of any provision contained in it on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended or on the grounds that any requirement of that Act as so amended or of any Instrument made under it has not been complied with in relation to the Order, may within 6 weeks from 1st October 1982 apply to the High Court for this purpose.
