WEST MIDLANDS COUNTY COUNCIL*The West Midlands County Council (Jewellery Quarter) (One Way Traffic) (Amendment) Order 1982*

Notice is hereby given that on 12th October 1982 the County Council of West Midlands made the above-named Order under sections 1(1)(2) and (3) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act, 1968, section 186 and Schedule 19 to the Local Government Act, 1972, section 24 and Schedule 6 to the Road Traffic Act 1974 and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with section 84C(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1967, the effect of which is as follows:

To reverse the traffic flow in Tenby Street North between Warstone Lane and Tenby Street (Traffic flow to be towards Tenby Street from Warstone Lane).

The Order will come into operation on 18th October 1982.

186 and Schedule 19 to the Local Government Act 1972 section 24 and Schedule 6 to the Road Traffic Act 1974 or on the grounds that any requirements of that Act or any instrument made under it has not been complied with in relation to this Order may within 6 weeks from 18th October 1982 apply to the High Court for this purpose.
