Licensed Non-residential Establishment Wages Council

The Licensed Non-residential Establishment Wages Council hereby gives notice of proposals for amending the provisions relating to public holidays as set out in:

(1) the Wages (Licensed Non-residential Establishment) (Bar Staff) (No. 2) Order 1980 (Order LNR (139)), as amended by the Wages (Licensed Non-residential Establishment) (Bar Staff) (Amendment) Order 1981 (Order LNR (143)); and (2) the Wages (Licensed Non-residential Establishment) (Club Stewards) (No. 2) Order 1980 (Order LNR (140)), as amended by the Wages (Licensed Non-residential Establishment) (Club Stewards) (Amendment) Order 1981 (Order LNR (144)). DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORT

TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACT 1971

- (d) On behalf of the local authority or their contractors in pursuance of their statutory powers and duties, and where the vehicle is:

(e) A pedestrian controlled motorised trolley which is operated on behalf of the Post Office.

The proposed Order will require the provision of a new highway which will be a road.

During 35 days from 15th October 1982 or within 35 days from the date of publication of this notice, if such period shall expire later, copies of the draft Order and relevant plan may be inspected at the Information Centre,
