Notice is hereby given that a Petition was on 21st October 1982 presented to Her Majesty's High Court of Justice in England by the above-named Minster Insurance Company Limited ("MIC") The Contingency Insurance Company Limited ("CIC") and Permanent Insurance Company Limited ("PIC") for:

- (i) the sanction of the Court as required by section 42 of the above-mentioned Act to a Scheme involving the transfer to PIC of the whole of the long term business (as defined by the said Act as amended by the Insurance Companies Act 1981) carried on by MIC and CIC
- (ii) an Order pursuant to section 43 of the said Act that all rights, benefits and advantages conferred on or vested in MIC and CIC by or under all contracts of insurance effected by them in the course of their respective long term businesses including the right to receive premiums shall be transferred to and vested in PIC on the Operative Date as defined in the Scheme
- (iii) an Order pursuant to the said section 43 that on the said Operative Date all the liabilities (whether present, future or contingent) imposed on MIC and CIC by or under all such contracts of insurance referred to at (ii) above shall be transferred to and become the liabilities of PIC; and
- (iv) an Order pursuant to the said section 43 that all legal proceedings (if any) which immediately prior to the Operative Date and pending by or against MIC or CIC and relating to the long term business of MIC or CIC be continued by or against PIC.

A copy of the said Petition (having annexed thereto a copy of the said Scheme) together with a copy of the report on the terms of the said Scheme by an independent actuary (as required by the said section 42 of the said Act) will be available for inspection from the date of this notice and for not less than 21 days at the registered offices of MIC and CIC situate at Minster House, Arthur Street, London EC4R 9BJ and at the registered office of PIC situate at 7-10 Chandos Street, London W1A 2LN and at each of their other offices whose addresses are specified in the schedule hereto during normal business hours on any day (other than a Saturday or Sunday) prior to the hearing of the said Petition.

And notice is hereby further given that the said Petition is directed to be heard before the Honourable Mr. Justice Mervyn Davies at the Royal Courts of Justice, Strand, London, on Monday, 13th December 1982, and any person (including any employee of MIC, CIC or PIC) who alleges that he or she would be adversely affected by the carrying out of the said Scheme may appear at the time of the hearing in person or by Counsel for that purpose, in which case he or she is requested to give 2 clear days previous notice in writing of his or her intention so to appear with the grounds of his or her objection to either of the under-mentioned Solicitors
