Both Armies in Flanders are separated, and his Grace the Duke of Marlborough, who is at prefent at Tournay, proposeth to be here towards the latter end of the next Week; feveral Officers of Distinction being already come hither, on their way to England. The Emperor arriv'd the Thirteenth Inftant at Milan; and we are advis'd from Germany, that his Imperial Majesty proposeth to reside for some time at Inspruck, till the necessary Dispositions are made for his Coronation at Brankfort, where he is not expected till the Twentieth of the next Month.
