

HIGHWAYS ACT 1980

1973 which is a route shown by a solid black band on the deposited plan between the south-west-bound carriageway of the route described in (a) above, in an easterly direction to a point where it meets the eastbound carriageway of the A46 Principal Road about 393 metres (430 yards) east of the centre point of the M1/M69/A46 junction, a distance measured along the said route of about 247 metres (270 yards).

Any person aggrieved by the Scheme and desiring to question the validity thereof, or any provision contained therein, on the ground that it is not within the powers of the Highways Act 1980, or on the ground that any requirement of that Act, or of regulations made thereunder, has not been complied with in relation to the Scheme, may, within 6 weeks from 19th November 1982, or within 6 weeks from the date of publication of this notice, if such a period shall expire later, apply to the High Court for the suspension or quashing of the Orders or of any provision contained therein.

The County Council of Merseyside (Woodside, Birkenhead to Arrowe Park, Birkenhead Classified Road) (Side Roads) Order 1979.

Any person aggrieved by the Order and desiring to question the validity thereof, or of any provision contained therein, on the ground that it is not within the powers of the Highways Act 1980, or on the ground that any requirement of that Act or of any regulations made thereunder has not been complied with in relation to the Order, may, within 6 weeks of 19th November 1982, apply to the High Court for the suspension or quashing of the Order or of any provision contained therein.
