NOTICE OF APPLICATION TO VARY A LICENCE TO ABSTRACT WATER

Notice is hereby given that an application is being made to the Thames Water Authority by the Rickmansworth & Uxbridge Valley Water Company, London Road, Rickmansworth, Herts WD3 1LB, to vary the licence serial No. 28/39/M3. This authorises (inter alia) the abstraction of water from underground strata (chalk) at Ordnance Survey National Grid Map ref. co-ordinates TQ 041 925—Springwell Lake, Harefield, London Borough of Hillingdon, at a maximum rate of 4,000,000 gallons per day and from like strata at Ordnance Survey National Grid Map ref. co-ordinates TQ 047 933—Stockers Lake, Harefield aforesaid at a maximum rate of 2,000,000 gallons per day.

The variation applied for is to enable 6,000,000 gallons of water to be abstracted per day from the source at Springwell Lake in any period during which water is not being abstracted from the source at Stockers Lake.
