West Dorset District (Dorchester Footpaths 38, 39 and 40) Public Path Order 1982

Notice is hereby given that the above-named Order, made on 24th December 1982 is about to be submitted to the Secretary of State for the Environment for confirmation, or to be confirmed by the West Dorset District Council, as an unopposed Order.

The effect of the Order, if confirmed without modification, will be as follows:

(a) to stop up Dorchester Footpath 38, which runs from map reference 68749029 on Damers Road northwards for 90 metres then westwards for 100 metres and finally north-eastwards for 240 metres to map reference 68569057 on Bridport Road, and Dorchester Footpath 39, which runs north-eastwards from its junction with Footpath 38 to map reference 68609058 on Bridport Road; and to create a new footpath running eastwards from the said map reference 68749029 on Damers Road for 60 metres then generally north-westwards for 350 metres and finally westwards for 30 metres to map reference 68609058 on Bridport Road;

(b) to divert that part of Dorchester Footpath 40 running north-westwards from map reference 68489042 for 130 metres to map reference 68469054 on Bridport Road to a new line running westwards from the said map reference 68489042 for 30 metres then north-westwards for 130 metres to map reference 68429053 on Bridport Road.
