Notice is hereby given that the North Bedfordshire Borough Council, acting as agents far the Bedfordshire County Council, propose to make an Order under sections 1 (1), (2) and (3) and 84D (1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended, the effect of which will be to:
