

(ii) a point approximately 33 metres from the junction with West Street southwards for a distance of approximately 20 metres.

(b) To wait for longer than 20 minutes between the hours of 8 a.m. and 6 p.m. on any day except Sunday on the eastern side of Maytree Road from a point approximately 19 metres from the junction with West Street southwards for a distance of approximately 14 metres.

The Order will contain the usual exemptions and will revoke all existing Traffic Regulation Orders so far as they relate to the eastern side of Maytree Road.

A copy of the Order and a map showing the road affected may be inspected at the office of the undersigned at Civic Offices, Civic Way, Fareham PO16 7PP, during usual office hours.

Any person who desires to question the validity of the Order, or of any provision contained in it on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended as aforesaid, or on the grounds that any requirements of that Act or any Instrument made under it has not been complied with in relation to the Order may, within 6 weeks of 3rd February 1983, apply to the High Court for this purpose.

- (5) The increase of the Standard Charge from the present £6 to £10. In addition it is proposed to introduce a further exemption from the payment of the Standard Charge in the case of drivers who purchase a parking ticket and then overstay their time by less than 1 hour and receive a Standard Charge Notice. In such cases they will, subject to certain conditions, be given the opportunity to purchase further tickets to the value of £1 in return for this further exemption from the Standard Charge.
