TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACT 1971

The Secretary of State for Transport hereby gives notice that he proposes to make an order under section 209 of the above Act to authorise the stopping up of Romney Road, Cross Carrfield Street and lengths of Carrfield Street, Carrfield Lane and 2 lengths of unnamed footpaths in the Carrfield Road Redevelopment Area, Sheffield to enable residential development to be carried out by the City of Sheffield Metropolitan District Council under Part III of the said Act.

NOTICE OF APPLICATION FOR LICENCE TO ABSTRACT WATER

Notice is hereby given that an application is being made to the Anglian Water Authority by Messrs. R. H. and C. Lyon and Son of Park Hill House, North Scarle Road, Eagle, Lincoln for a licence to abstract 2,700,000 gallons of water during the months of April to September inclusive from a catchpit in the gravels at map reference SK. 864 687.

The water is to be used for spray irrigation purposes on arable farm crops.
