#### CERTIFICATES OF TAX DEPOSIT (SERIES 6)

On and after 7th March 1983 the rates of interest applicable to deposits accepted under the Prospectus (Series 6) dated 11th October 1982 will be as follows:

(a) for deposits of £100,000 or over:
