TENDERS FOR TREASURY BILLS

1. The Lords Commissioners of Her Majesty's Treasury hereby give notice that Tenders will be received at the Chief Registrar's Office (Bank Buildings) at the Bank of England, on Thursday, 31st March 1983 at 1 p.m., for Treasury Bills to be issued under the Treasury Bills Act 1877, and the National Loans Act 1968, to the amount of £100,000,000.

2. The Bills will be in amounts of $\pounds 5,000, \pounds 10,000, \pounds 25,000, \pounds 50,000, \pounds 100,000, \pounds 250,000$ or $\pounds 1,000,000$. They will be dated at the option of the tenderer on any business

day from Tuesday, 5th April 1983 to Friday, 8th April 1983 inclusive and will be due 91 days after date.

3. The Bills will be issued and paid at the Bank of England.

4. Each Tender must be for an amount not less than $\pounds 5,000$ and must specify the date on which the Bills required are to be dated and the net amount per cent. (being a multiple of one halfpenny) which will be given for the amount applied for. Separate Tenders must be lodged for Bills of different dates.

5. Tenders must be made through a London Banker, Discount House or Broker.

6. Notification will be sent on the same day as Tenders are received to the persons whose Tenders are accepted in whole or in part. Payment in full of the amounts due
