#### *Notice of Submission of Draft Regulation Entitled Supplementary Benefits Amendment Regulations 1983*

The Social Security Advisory Committee gives notice that it has been asked by the Secretary of State for Social Services under section 10 of the Social Security Act 1980 to consider and report on the draft of regulations entitled Supplementary Benefit Amendment Regulations 1983.

A short explanatory note provided by the Department of Health and Social Security on these regulations is appended to this notice. The Committee will take into account any comments or objections made by or on behalf of people or organizations who would be affected by the regulations received by them not later than 29th April 1983. #### EXPLANATORY NOTE

These regulations give effect to proposals submitted to the Committee earlier this month and to additional changes, including some announced in the recent Budget statement. The main additional changes are:

- (i) an end to the invalidity trap: periods in receipt if invalidity benefits and other long-term incapacity benefits will count towards the qualifying period for the long-term rate of supplementary benefit;
- (ii) the first £1,500 of the surrender value of life assurance policies will not be regarded as capital for supplementary benefit purposes;
- (iii) single people without accommodation will be entitled to meals allowances rather than the supplementary benefit non-householder rate, an increase from £2.95 to £3.65 a day;
