

The Order which comes into operation on 18th May 1983 makes it unlawful for any person to permit any vehicle:

(a) To wait at any time in the following lengths of Mill Road:

(i) The northern side for distances of approximately 22 metres to the west and 19 metres to the east of either side of the access road to the Mill Road Boatyard.

(ii) Both sides of the access road to the Mill Road Boatyard in a northerly direction for distances of approximately 15 metres from the junction with Mill Road.

(b) To wait between the hours 8 a.m. and 6 p.m. on any day except Sunday on the southern side of Mill Road from a point approximately 22 metres west of the junction with Beaconsfield Road in a westerly direction for a distance of approximately 50 metres.

A copy of the Order and a map showing the roads affected may be inspected at the office of the undersigned at Civic Offices, Civic Way, Fareham PO16 7PP, during usual office hours.

Any person who desires to question the validity of the Order, or of any provision contained in it on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended as aforesaid, or on the grounds that any requirement of that Act or any Instrument made under it has not been complied with in relation to the Order may within 6 weeks of 21st April 1983 apply to the High Court for this purpose.

Kettering Borough Council Prohibition of Waiting (Albert Street, Kettering) 1983 Order 2

Notice is hereby given that the Administrative Council of the Borough of Kettering as agents of the Northamptonshire County Council propose to make an Order under section 1 (1), (2) and (3) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968, Schedule 19 to the Local Government Act 1972 and Schedule 6 to the Road Traffic Act 1974, the effect of which will be to prohibit the waiting of vehicles at all times in the vicinity of the turning head at the western end of Albert Street, Kettering.

Exceptions to the Order will permit waiting for the purpose of picking up and setting down passengers, loading and unloading goods, delivery and collection of postal packets, in connection with weddings and funerals, and gas, water and electricity. The usual exemptions will apply to disabled persons' vehicles bearing the relevant badge.

North side, from a point 15 metres west of its junction with Southgate Drive to a point 15 metres east of its junction with Southgate Drive.

Windmill Avenue, east side, from its junction with Deeble Road to a point 30 metres north of its junction with Beech Crescent.

Southgate Drive, both sides, from its junction with Deeble Road for a distance of 15 metres in a northerly direction.

Kettering Borough Council (York Road, Tennyson Road, Green Lane and Russell Street, Kettering) (One-way Traffic and Prohibition of Waiting) 1983 Order 3.

(1) No person shall cause any vehicle to proceed in that length of road specified in column 1 of the First Schedule to this notice in a direction other than that specified in relation to that length of road in column 2 of that Schedule.

(2) To prohibit waiting of vehicles in any of the lengths of road specified in the Second and Third Schedules to this notice.

The usual exemptions will apply to disabled persons' vehicles bearing the relevant badge.
