

- I. The rate of interest applicable to any such fixed rate loan will be that in force on the day the authority applies to borrow or, if the application is before noon three working days before the loan is credited to the account of the authority's banker, the rate in force at 11 a.m. two banking days before credit day;
- II. Different rates of interest shall be charged on such fixed rate loans according to whether the principal of a loan is repaid by instalments or at maturity and, if repaid by instalments, whether by equal instalments of the principal with interest paid on the decreasing balance of the principal (E.I.P.), or by instalments of equal repayments of the principal and interest paid thereon (E.R.);
- III. The rates of such interest shall be:

### The Trunk Road (A48) (Carmarthen, Dyfed) (Prohibition of U-Turns) Order 1983

Notice is hereby given that the Secretary of State for Wales proposes to make an Order under section 1 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended. The effect of the proposed Order will be:

- (a) to prohibit (with certain exceptions) any vehicle proceeding in the eastbound carriageway of that length of the trunk road specified in the Schedule to this notice to make a U-turn through any of the gaps in the central reservation so as to proceed in the opposite direction in the westbound carriageway of the trunk road;
- (b) to prohibit (with certain exceptions) any vehicle proceeding in the westbound carriageway of that length of the trunk road specified in the Schedule to this notice to make a U-turn through any of the gaps in the central reservation so as to proceed in the opposite direction in the eastbound carriageway of the trunk road.
