## DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORT

### TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACT 1971

### TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACT 1971

### TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACT 1971

### ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1967, SECTION 1

#### *The Trunk Road (Church Road, Litherland) (Prohibition of Waiting) (Revocation) Order 1983*

Notice is hereby given that the Secretary of State for Transport has made an Order under section 1(1), (2) and (3) and 84D (1) of the Road Traffic Act 1967 as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968 on the Boole-North of Aintree Trunk Road (A567) known as Church Road, Litherland, in the County of Merseyside.

The effect of the Order which comes into operation on 22nd August 1983, is to permit waiting in front of the properties numbers 116, 118, 120, 122 Church Road, Litherland, and will revoke part of an Order known as "The Trunk Road (Church Road Litherland) (Prohibition of Waiting) Order 1973". The extent of the revocation is from a point 9 metres (9.8 yards) south-west of the centre line of St. Matthews Avenue to a point 38 metres (41.4 yards) south-west of the centre line of St. Matthews Avenue.

Any person who desires to question the validity of, or any provision contained in the Order, on the ground that it is not within the powers with respect to the Order conferred by the above Act, or on the ground that any requirement of, or of any Instrument made under any provision of that Act has not been complied with in relation to the Order may, within 6 weeks of 22nd August 1983, apply to the High Court for the suspension or quashing of the Order or of any provision contained therein.
