## CORNWALL COUNTY COUNCIL

*The County of Cornwall (Truro) (Restrictions on Waiting) (Amendment) Order 1983*

Notice is hereby given that on 22nd August 1983 the Council made the above Order (operative from 2nd September 1983) to regulate traffic at Truro (subject to the normal exceptions operating in Cornwall, including the disabled persons exception) by:

- prohibiting the waiting of vehicles on any day other than a Sunday in the lengths of road specified in the Schedule; and
- amending the existing traffic regulation Order as necessary to give effect to the foregoing.
