The Devon County Council (Various Streets, Braunton) (Traffic Regulation) Order 1983

Notice is hereby given that on 23rd August 1983 the Devon County Council made an Order under sections 1 and 84 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended, the effect of which is to prohibit any vehicle from waiting:

- (a) in specified lengths of Abbots Hill, Church Street and Sings Lane;
- (b) between the hours of 9 a.m. and 10 p.m. in a specified length of Exeter Road

There are exceptions in the Order, which comes into operation on 5th September 1983 relating to the picking up and setting down of passengers, loading and unloading of goods, disabled persons vehicles and where necessary in connection with the maintenance of the road and the supply of gas, water and electricity.

DEVON COUNTY COUNCIL

The County of Devon (Solsbro Road, Torquay) (Street Parking Places) Order 1983

and

The County of Devon (Solsbro Road, Torquay) (Prohibition of Waiting) Order 1983

Notice is hereby given that on 22nd August 1983, the Devon County Council made Orders under sections 1 (1), (2), (3), 28 (1), 31 (1) and 53 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended.

When the Orders come into effect on 2nd September 1983:

- (1) The use of the following length of Solsbro Road will be authorised for the parking of coaches only at all times from 1st May to 30th September (both dates inclusive) in every year:

Solsbro Road, west side, from a point 80 metres north of its junction with Hennapyn Road northwards for a distance of 50 metres.

- (2) you will not be allowed to leave your vehicle at any time in the following lengths of road:

Solsbro Road

East side, full length of railway premises, from its junction with Hennapyn Road to and including the cul-de-sac end;

West side, from its junction with Hennapyn Road for a distance of 30 metres;

West side, from a point 130 metres from Hennapyn Road to the cul-de-sac end, including both sides of the length leading westwards from the cul-de-sac end for a distance of 13 metres in a westerly direction.

Exemptions to (2) above permit waiting for the purpose of boarding and alighting loading and unloading, Post Office services, maintenance of the road, supply of gas, water and electricity, pursuance of statutory powers or duties, taking in petrol, oil or air from a garage. The statutory exemptions for disabled persons' vehicles are included.

Copies of the Orders together with maps showing the lengths of road affected may be inspected during usual office hours, Monday to Friday, at the offices of the Town Clerk and Chief Executive Officer, Borough of Torbay, Town Hall, Torquay, or at the address given below.

If you wish to question the validity of these Orders or any provision made under them on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the relevant section of the Act or that any requirement of the Act or any regulation made under it has not been complied with, you may, within 6 weeks of the date of this Order, apply to the High Court for that purpose.
