#### GREATER MANCHESTER COUNTY COUNCIL

*Road Traffic Orders—Romiley, Stockport*

Notice is hereby given that the Greater Manchester County Council propose to make Orders under section 1 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended.

The Orders and their effect would be:

1. *Greater Manchester County (Padden Brook, Romiley) (Prohibition of Waiting) (County) Order 1983*

To prohibit waiting at any time on:

*Padden Brook*, Romiley, both sides, from its junction with Gorse Brow for 15 metres in a southerly direction.

The proposed Order contains exemptions for the purposes of boarding or alighting, loading or unloading, building operations, funerals or work on or under the length of road. Disabled persons' vehicles displaying a disabled person's badge and a parking disc will be allowed to wait for up to 2 hours, return prohibited within 1 hour.

2. *Greater Manchester County (Padden Brook, Romiley) (Weight Restriction) (County) Order 1983*

To prohibit any goods vehicle which has a gross weight exceeding 7.5 tonnes from proceeding along Padden Brook from a point 65 metres south of its junction with Gorse Brow in a southerly direction to the cul de sac end.

Access will be allowed for the conveyance of persons, goods or merchandise to premises adjacent to the lengths of road in connection with building operations or work on or under the length of road and for garaging, servicing or repairing a vehicle at any premises adjacent to the length of road.

Copies of the Orders and maps showing the roads to which they relate together with statements of the Council's reasons for proposing to make the Orders may be inspected between the hours of 9 a.m. and 4.30 p.m. on Monday to Friday at the County Legal Office, County Hall, Piccadilly Gardens, Manchester, and the Director of Administration's Office, Town Hall, Stockport.

Objections to either of the proposals together with the grounds on which they are made must be sent to me in writing by 26th September 1983.

#### WEST MIDLANDS COUNTY COUNCIL

*The West Midlands County Council (Huntly Road/Skipton Road, Ladywood) (Prohibition of Waiting) Order 1983*
