NEW FOREST DISTRICT COUNCIL

District of New Forest (Various Roads) (Prohibition of Waiting) Order 1983

Notice is hereby given that the District Council of New Forest pursuant to arrangements made under section 101 of the Local Government Act 1972 with the County Council of Hampshire in exercise of the powers of the said County Council propose to make an Order under sections 1 (1), (2),

(3) and 84D (1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968, by Schedule 19 to the Local Government Act 1972 and by Schedule 6 to the Road Traffic Act 1974.

The effect of this Order will be to prohibit the waiting by vehicles on the lengths and sides of roads specified in the Schedules hereto.

Exceptions in the Order will permit waiting for the purposes of picking up and setting down passengers, loading and unloading goods and, where necessary, in connection with the maintenance of roads and the supply of gas, water and electricity.

NORFOLK COUNTY COUNCIL

The Norfolk County Council (Market Place, Aylsham) Experimental (Traffic Regulation) (Extension No. 2) Order 1983

Notice is hereby given that the Norfolk County Council have made an Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended, which will extend for a further period of six months, the Norfolk County Council (Market Place, Aylsham) Experimental (Traffic Regulation) Order 1982. The effect of the Order is to:—

- (i) Prohibit the waiting of vehicles between 8 a.m. and 6 p.m. on Mondays to Saturdays inclusive, in the whole of the Market Place, in the Parish of Aylsham, excepting those areas defined as street parking places in the Schedule below. Waiting will be permitted for the purposes of picking up and setting down passengers, loading and unloading goods and the supply of gas, electricity and water. The parking of doctors' cars adjacent to the surgery will also be permitted.
- (ii) Prohibit the driving of any vehicles on the new link road between the main carriageway and the west side of the Market Place at the "Black Boys" corner, in the Parish of Aylsham, otherwise than in a south to north direction;
- (iii) Provide street parking places in those sections of road specified in the Schedule below.

A copy of the Order, which comes into force on 24th September, 1983, and relevant plan may be inspected at County Hall, Martineau Lane, Norwich, during office hours.

Any person who desires to question the validity of the Order or of any provision contained in it on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended, or on the grounds that any requirement of that Act, or of any instrument made under it, has not been complied with in relation to the Order, may within 6 weeks from 13th September, 1983, apply to the High Court for this purpose.
