CHESTER CITY COUNCIL

The City of Chester (Shipgate Street) (Prohibition of Waiting) Order 1983

Notice is hereby given that on 20th September 1983 the Council of the City of Chester, pursuant to arrangements made under the Local Government Act 1972 with Cheshire County Council, made an Order under sections 1 (1), (2), (3) and 84D (1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968, Schedule 19 to the Local Government Act 1972 and Schedule 6 to the Road Traffic Act 1974.

The effect of the Order, which will become operative on 26th September 1983, will be to prohibit waiting at any time on the south-east side of Shipgate Street between a point 40 feet from its junction with Lower Bridge Street and a point 50 feet from its southerly end.

If you wish to question the validity of the Order, or of any provisions contained within it, on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended as aforesaid, or on the grounds that any requirement of the Act, or of any instrument made under them, has not been

complied with in relation to the Order, you may, within 6 weeks from 26th September 1983, apply to the High Court for that purpose.
