HAMPSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL

*The Hampshire (Greatham)
(40 miles per hour speed limit) Order 1983*

Notice is hereby given that on 15th September 1983, Hampshire County Council made a Road Traffic Regulation Order as follows:

Effect of Order: a 40 m.p.h. speed limit will be imposed on the following lengths of road at Greatham:

- (i) That length of the A325 Petersfield Road between a point 592 metres south of its junction with the B2131 Longmoor Road (i.e. the southern end of the existing 40 m.p.h. speed restriction) and a point 125 metres south of its junction with the B3006 Greatham-Alton road, a distance of approximately 584 metres.
- (ii) That length of the B3006 Greatham-Alton road between its junction with the A325 Petersfield Road and a point 293 metres west thereof.

Date of Operation: The Order will come into operation on 29th September 1983.

Application to the High Court: Any person who desires to question the validity of the Order or of any provision contained in the Order on the grounds that it is not within the powers of sections 74 and 84D of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, or on the grounds that any requirement of those sections or of section 84A, 84B or 84C of the Act or any regulations made under the said section 84C have not been complied with in relation to the Order may, by 27th October 1983, make application for the purpose to the High Court.

IPSWICH BOROUGH COUNCIL

*Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967 (Section 1)
Ipswich Borough Council (Heavy Commercial Vehicles)
(Exceeding 7.5 Tonnes Maximum Gross Weight)
(Prohibition of Entry) (Norwich Road/Whitehouse Road/
Bramford Road Areas) Order 1983*

Notice is hereby given that Ipswich Borough Council as agents for Suffolk County Council made the above-mentioned Order under section 1 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967 on 21st September 1983.

When this Order comes into operation it will prohibit heavy commercial vehicles (exceeding maximum gross weight of 7.5 tonnes) from entering an area bounded by Norwich Road, Whitehouse Road, the Borough Boundary, Bramford Road and the Ipswich-Felixstowe railway line between Bramford Road and Norwich Road. Exceptions to this Order will be made to enable these vehicles of the class mentioned to gain entry to the restricted area for loading and unloading purposes and for off-street parking.

A copy of the Order and a map showing the restricted roads are available for inspection at my offices at Civic Centre, Civic Drive, Ipswich between the hours of 9.30 a.m. to 4.30 p.m. Mondays to Fridays.

Anyone wishing to question the validity of the Order or of any provision contained in it on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Act of 1967 or on the grounds that any requirement of that Act or of any instrument made under it has not been complied with in relation to this Order may within 6 weeks from 28th September 1983 apply to the High Court for this purpose.

The Order will come into operation on 22nd September 1983.

HIGHWAYS ACTS

GWENT COUNTY COUNCIL

The County Council of Gwent (Henllys Way to Llywelyn Road, Cwmbran, Classified Road) (Side Roads) Order 1982

Any person aggrieved by the Order and desiring to question the validity thereof, or of any provision contained therein on the grounds that it is not within the powers of the Highways Act 1980 or on the grounds that any requirement of the Highways Act 1980 or of any regulation made thereunder has not been complied with in relation to the Order, may, within 6 weeks of 28th September 1983, apply to the High Court for the suspension or quashing of the Order or of any provision contained therein.
