*Notice of Proposals for Licences to Abstract Water and to Obstruct or Impede the Flow of an Inland Water by means of Impounding Water.*

Notice is hereby given that the Severn-Trent Water Authority (hereinafter called "the Authority") whose head office is at Abelson House, 2297 Coventry Road, Sheldon, Birmingham B26 3PR have formulated proposals to obstruct or impede the flow of an unnamed watercourse flowing into Llyn Clywedog at national grid ref. SN 884 892 at Gronwen, Llanidloes, Powys by means of a masonry faced weir and to abstract the following quantities of water: 2 cubic metres per hour; 8 cubic metres per day and 1,000 cubic metres per year from the said inland water at or near that point.

The abstracted water will be used for the purpose of supply to toilet facilities and the weir will provide a gravity abstraction.

**ROAD TRAFFIC ACTS**

**AVON COUNTY COUNCIL**

*County of Avon (Gloucester Road Area, Bishopston, City of Bristol) (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting) Order 1983.*
