#### SOLIHULL METROPOLITAN BOROUGH COUNCIL

*The Metropolitan Borough of Solihull (Manor Road, Solihull)  
(Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting) Order, 1983.*

Notice is hereby given that the Solihull Metropolitan Borough Council, as agent of the West Midlands County Council, propose to make the above mentioned Order under Section 1 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended.

The effect of the Order will be to prohibit waiting, at the times indicated, on the following lengths of road:—

- (1) Waiting Prohibited at all times.
  - (a) Both sides of Manor Road, Solihull, from a point 25 metres south-west of its junction with Thornby Avenue to a point 20 metres north-east of that junction.
  - (b) Both sides of Thornby Avenue, Solihull, from its junction with Manor Road to a point 20 metres north-west of that junction.
- (2) Waiting prohibited between 8 a.m. and 6 p.m. on Mondays to Saturdays.
  - (a) the north-west side of Manor Road, Solihull from a point 15 metres from its junction with Warwick Road to a point 25 metres south-west of its junction with Thornby Avenue.
- (3) Waiting Prohibited from 10 a.m. to 3 p.m. on Mondays to Fridays.
  - (a) The south-east side of Manor Road, Solihull from a point 15 metres from its junction with Warwick Road to a point 25 metres south-west of its junction with Thornby Avenue.

Canning Town Library, London Borough of Newham, Barking Road, Canning Town, E16—between 9.30 a.m. and 5 p.m.—Mondays to Saturdays (until 7 p.m. Mondays, Tuesdays, Thursdays and Fridays).

The Plan became operative on the 12th October 1983, but if any person aggrieved by the Plan desires to question its validity on the ground that it is not within the powers conferred by Part II of the Town and Country Planning Act 1971 or that any requirement of the said Part II or of any regulations made
