It is important, therefore, that any objection should include a full statement in writing of the grounds on which the objection is made, as the objector may have no further opportunity to make such a statement.

Any owner or occupier of any of the land to which the Order relates may (whether or not he makes an objection to the Order) send to the Telford Development Corporation, Priorslee Hall, Telford, Shropshire TF2 9NT, a request in writing that, in the event of the Order being confirmed by the Secretary of State, he be served with a notice stating that the Order has been confirmed and naming a place where a copy of the Order and of the map or maps and any descriptive matter annexed thereto may be seen.
