

**RATES OF INTEREST ON LOANS FROM  
THE NATIONAL LOANS FUND**

**NOTICE**

The Treasury in pursuance of section 5 of the National Loans Act 1968 (as amended) hereby give notice that on or after 16th November 1983:

- I. Different rates of interest shall apply according to whether the principal of a loan is repaid by instalments or at maturity and, if repaid by instalments, whether by equal instalments of the principal with interest paid on the decreasing balance of the principal (E.I.P.), or by instalments of equal repayments of the principal and interest paid thereon (E.R.);
- II. The lowest rates of interest satisfying the conditions laid down in subsection (3) of the said section 5 shall be:

**MISUSE OF DRUGS ACT 1971, SECTIONS 13 AND 14**

*Direction Prohibiting Exercise of Powers in Relation to  
Controlled Drugs*  
Dasrath Rai

Notice is hereby given, in accordance with section 16 (2) of the Misuse of Drugs Act 1971, that the Secretary of State has given the following direction, which came into effect on 10th November 1983.

The Secretary of State, in pursuance of subsection (2) of section 13 of the Misuse of Drugs Act 1971, and in accordance with section 14 of that Act, by this Direction, prohibits Dr. Dasrath Rai, M.S.M.F., a doctor within the meaning of that Act, whose registered address is Ground Floor, 44 Harley Street, London W.1, from prescribing, administering and supplying and from authorising the administration and supply of any of the following substances and products controlled within the meaning of that Act namely:

- (a) dipipanone, dextromoramide and methylphenidate;
- (b) any stereoisomeric form of a substance specified in paragraph (a) above;
- (c) any salt of a substance specified in paragraphs (a) or (b) above;
- (d) any preparation or other products containing a substance specified in any of the paragraphs (a) to (c) above.

This Direction does not extend to the doing of anything in circumstances in which it might lawfully be done without being a doctor.

**NOTICE OF SEIZURE UNDER THE CUSTOMS  
AND EXCISE MANAGEMENT ACT 1979**

Pursuant to section 139 (6) of the Customs and Excise Management Act 1979 and paragraph 1 of the 3rd Schedule thereto. the Commissioners of Customs and Excise hereby

give you notice that by virtue of the powers contained in the Customs and Excise Acts and any enactments amending those Acts, certain goods, namely:

1 ROHM RG 77 '22 calibre gas pistol plus 3 cartridges has been seized as liable to forfeiture upon the grounds that the said goods were imported contrary to the prohibition contained in the Import of Goods (Control) Order 1954 made under the Import, Export and Customs Powers (Defence) Act 1939.

Whereby and by force of section 49 (b) of the Customs & Excise Management Act 1979 and section 3 (1) of the Import, Export and Customs Powers (Defence) Act 1939 the said goods are liable to forfeiture.

If you claim that the said goods are not liable to forfeiture you must within one month from the date of this notice of seizure give notice of your claim in accordance with the said Schedule to the said Act specifying the name and address of a solicitor in the United Kingdom who is authorised to accept service of process and to act on your behalf. In default of such notice the said goods will be deemed to have been duly condemned as forfeited and will be liable to be disposed of in such manner as the Commissioners of Customs and Excise may direct. If you make such claim within the time aforesaid, legal proceedings will be taken for the condemnation thereof.
