If any person aggrieved by the Order desires to question its validity, or the validity of any provision contained in it, on the ground that it is not within the powers conferred by the above Act or that any requirement of that Act or of any regulations made under it has not been complied with in relation to the Order, he or she may, within 6 weeks from 13th February 1984, apply to the High Court for the suspension or quashing of the Order or of any provision contained in it.

Unless the Order is suspended or quashed as a consequence of any such application, any person who on 13th February 1984, has/had an interest in land having lawful access to a highway to which the Order relates may claim to be entitled to be compensated by the Rushcliffe Borough Council in respect of any depreciation in the value of his or her interest which is directly attributable to the Order and of any other loss or damage which is to attributable. Any claim must be served on the Council at its above address within a period of 6 months from 13th February 1984, unless the period is extended in any particular case by the Secretary of State.
