#### ROCHDALE BOROUGH COUNCIL

*The Greater Manchester County (Sladen Street and Grasmere Street, Rochdale) (Prohibition of Waiting) (Borough) Order 1979.*

Notice is hereby given that the Rochdale Borough Council, pursuant to arrangements made under section 101 of the Local Government Act 1972 with the County Council of Greater Manchester in exercise of the powers of the said County Council under section 1 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended, made an Order prohibiting waiting at any time on the lengths of road specified in the Schedule to this notice.

The Order contains exemptions to allow vehicles to wait:

A copy of the Order and a map showing the lengths of road concerned may be inspected at the Information Office, Municipal Offices, Smith Street, Rochdale, between the hours of 8.30 a.m. and 12.30 p.m. and 1.30 p.m. and 4.45 p.m. Mondays to Fridays inclusive.

If you wish to question the validity of the Order or of any provisions contained in it on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended, or on the grounds that any requirement of that act or any Instrument made under it has not been complied with in relation to the Order, you may, within 6 weeks from 13th February 1984, apply to the High Court for this purpose.

*Suffolk County Council (Durbar Terrace, Bury St. Edmunds) (Prohibition of Driving) Order 1984*
