#### PRIVY COUNCIL OFFICE

#### **PUBLIC SCHOOLS ACT 1868**

The Governing Body of Westminster School have made a Statute in the terms appended hereto, the same is hereby published in the London Gazette as required by the abovenamed Act.

Any persons or body corporate authorised by the said Act may within two months after the publication hereof petition Her Majesty in Council to withhold Her approval from the whole or any part of the said Statute.

Statute made by the Governing Body of Westminster

Statute made by the Governing Body of Westminster School on 31st January 1984.

We, the Governing Body of St. Peter's College, Westminster, commonly called Westminster School, in virtue of the powers invested in us by the Public Schools Act 1868 and of all other powers enabling us in that behalf do hereby make the following Statute amending the Statute sealed with our Common Seal the 17th May 1869, as subsequently amended.

#### STATUTE

1. This Statute shall take effect from and after the approval thereof by Her Majesty in Council.

2. The whole of Chapter VII headed 'Investment of Capital Monies' shall be deleted from the Statute sealed with our corporate seal the 28th July 1871 and approved by the Queen in Council on 3rd November 1871 (as subsequently amended) and the following new Chapter VII substituted therefore:

#### "Chapter VII Investment of Capital Monies

1. Any capital monies for the time being in the hands of the Governing Body may be invested by them in such stocks, funds shares, securities of other investments or whatsoever nature and wheresoever and whether real or personal including the purchase of real property in the United Kingdom or elsewhere being either freehold or leasehold land held upon a lease or underlease having not less than 50 years unexpired, with power (with the consent of the Charity Commissioners when so required by law) to sell, assign, lease or mortgage any such land as aforesaid and with the like absolute power or varying such investments from time to time to the intent that the Governing Body shall have the same full and unrestricted Governing Body shall have the same full and unrestricted

power of the investment and transposing of investments in all respects as if they were absolutely entitled thereto beneficially.

2. In making any investment the Governing Body shall have regard to the need for diversification of investments so far as is appropriate to the circumstances of Westminster School and to the suitability of investments of the descrip-tion of investment proposed and before making any investment they shall obtain and consider proper advice on the question whether the investment is satisfactory having regard to the matters aforesaid.

For the purpose of this clause proper advice means

For the purpose of this clause proper advice means the advice given in writing or subsequently confirmed in writing of a person who is reasonably believed by the Governing Body to be qualified by his ability in and practical experience of financial matters.

3. For the avoidance of doubt it is hereby declared that the provisions of the Trustee Investments Act 1961 or any statutory modification or re-enactment thereof for the time being shall not be binding upon the Governing Body."
