ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1967

The Trunk Road (A483) (Swansea-Manchester) (Belgrave, South of Chester Cheshire) (De-restriction) Order 1984

Notice is hereby given that the Secretary of State for Transport proposes to make an Order under section 72 (3) and 73 (1) and (2) of the Road Traffic Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968, the effect of which will be that the length of road specified in the Schedule to this notice shall cease to be a restricted road and will revert to the national speed limit of 60 m.p.h. This length of road is subject to a 30 m.p.h. limit by virtue of the street lighting system. However, the application of the Department's speed limit criteria would not support such a limit.
