DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORT

TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACT 1971

The Secretary of State for Transport hereby gives notice that on the application of the City of Bradford Metropolitan Council, he proposes to make an order under section 212 of the above Act to provide for the extinguishment of any right which persons may have to use vehicles on an area of Carlisle Street, Bradford.

The proposed Order will contain provisions for permitting the use of that highway by vehicles being used:

- (a) for police, ambulance or fire brigade purposes;
- (b) on behalf of a statutory undertaker or British Telecommunications and engaged upon the laying, erection, inspection, maintenance, alteration, repair, renewal or removal of any main, pipe, conduit, wire, cable or other apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity or of any telegraphic line as defined in the Telegraph Act 1878 under, in, on, over, along or across the highway or any land adjacent to the highway;

(c) on behalf of a water authority and engaged upon the laying, inspection, maintenance, alteration, repair, renewal or removal of any public sewer under, in, on, over, along or across the highway or any land adjacent to the highway.

During 28 days from 14th March 1984 copies of the draft Order and relevant plans may be inspected at the office of The Group Engineer (Roads), City of Bradford Metropolitan Council, Jacobs Well, Bradford BD1 5RW and at the Central Library, Prince's Way, Bradford BD1 1NN, and may be obtained free of charge from the Department of Transport (quoting DYH5111/41/7/31) at the address stated below.

Within the above-mentioned period of 28 days, any person may by notice to the Secretary of State (Ref.: DYH5111/41/7/31), at his address at the office of the Director (Transport), Yorkshire and Humberside Region, City House, Leeds LS1 4JD, object to the making of the Order.

NOTICE OF APPLICATION FOR LICENCE TO ABSTRACT WATER

Notice is hereby given that an application is being made to the Southern Water Authority by Miller & Bradley of Selson Farm, Eastry, Sandwich, Kent, for a licence to abstract the following quantities of water from a small tributary to the River Wingham in the Parish of Woodnesborough at the following point of abstraction:
